




Caledon is home to globally competitive industries including agriculture and food processing, advanced manufacturing, and logistics - powered by a highly skilled workforce and a culture of innovation.

DMZ INCUBATOR

The DMZ Incubator is our flagship program for high-growth tech startups, offering founders 18 months of expert coaching, investment readiness support, and access to one of Canada's top innovation networks. The program is open to tech entrepreneurs from across the globe.

DMZ STARTUP VISA PROGRAM

The DMZ Startup Visa Program helps international entrepreneurs build and scale their companies in Canada while supporting their pathway to permanent residency in the country.

DMZ YYZ

DMZ YYZ is a soft landing program that helps international startups explore the Canadian market through mentorship, guided exposure, and strategic ecosystem connections over a two-week intensive bootcamp in Toronto, Canada.
